

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

Any area numbered section of Dominion land in the Northwest Territories...

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land to be taken is situated...

HOMESTEAD DUTIES: A settler who has been granted an entry for a homestead is required to perform the conditions...

(1) At least six months residence upon the cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three years.

(2) If the father, mother, or the father in the case of any person who is unable to make a homestead entry...

(3) If the settler has his permanent residence upon the land in each year during the term of three years...

APPLICATION FOR PATENT should be made at the end of three years, before the local surveyor, and the homestead land should be surveyed...

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST MINING REGULATIONS

Coal—Coal lands may be purchased at \$10 per acre for coal and \$20 for surface...

Quartz—A free miner's certificate is granted upon payment in advance of \$7.50 per acre...

A free miner, having discovered mineral in place, may locate a claim 1,500 ft. x 500 ft.

The fee for recording a claim is \$5. At least \$100 must be expended on the claim each year...

A free miner may obtain two leases to locate for gold or five miles each for a term of three years...
