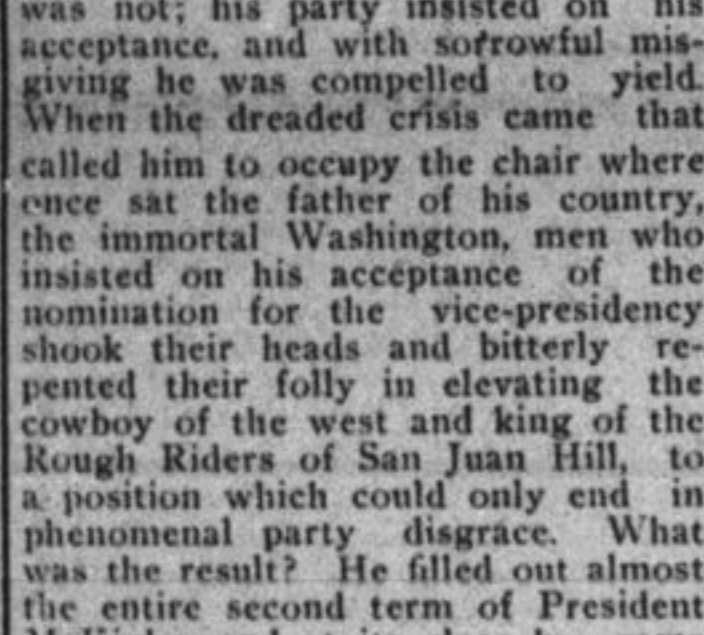

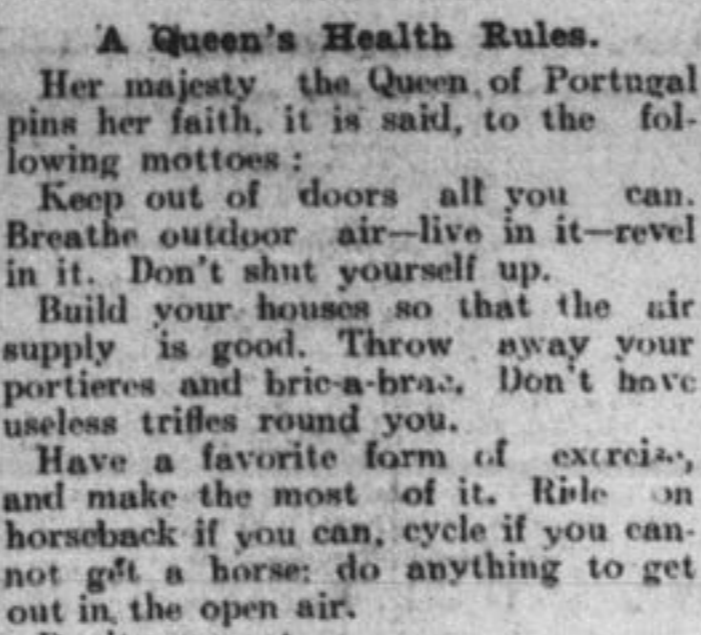

NEWS OF CHURCHES

THE VARIOUS DOINGS IN THE RELIGIOUS WORLD.

Number of Protestant Christians - The Bible Society is Out of Debt - Calls and Invitations to Clergymen.

Rev. A. J. Macgillivray, London, accepted a call to Vancouver.

Rev. J. D. McLachlan, M.A., Tank Hill, has been called to the Galt Baptist church.

The King of the Island of Nukoro, Poline Islands, is also the preacher of the teacher for his people.

Stewarton Presbyterians have decided to erect a new church to accommodate 1,200 persons, at a cost of \$25,000.

Rev. M. C. McLean, pastor of the Baptist church, Galt, has assumed the pastorate of the Ingersoll Baptist church.

A tablet was recently unveiled at Addam, Conn. in memory of David Garrison, the missionary to the North American Indians.

The American Bible Society finds itself for the first time in a quarter of a century in debt.

Rev. W. F. Roadhouse, pastor of the Baptist church, Parry Sound, has resigned and has been succeeded by the Rev. J. H. Galt.

Rev. E. W. R. Real, B.A., has resigned the curacy of St. Luke's church, Toronto, and will sever his connection with that parish on the first of April.

Three missions in India have been specially qualified men as travelling Christian Endeavor secretaries, two of them being also inspecting schoolmasters.

Rev. R. G. Watt, pastor of the Congregational church, Melbourne, Ont., who received a call to Barrie, Ont., has decided to remain on with his congregation.

Rev. Frederick Preston, has resigned the pastorate of Unity church (Unitarian), Toronto, and the resignation takes effect at once.

Rev. Dr. Thomas, formerly pastor of Jarvis Street Baptist church, Toronto, will go to Edinburgh, Scotland, shortly, to fill the vacant pulpit of Dublin Street Baptist church.

Rev. Hugh Watson, late of Ireland, who recently arrived in Toronto, has received and accepted the unanimous call to the pastorate of the Baptist churches in Watford and Calgary.

The Emmanuel Congregational church, Watertown, N.Y., has extended a call to Rev. Charles Dutton New Haven, Conn., to fill the pulpit recently vacant by Rev. H. H. Pyle, who went to accept a call in a "parkville" Congregational church Brooklyn.

It is stated that Rev. E. B. Macdonald will resign the pastorate of a church in Scarborough. He is a brother of J. A. Macdonald, of the Toronto, and has been in charge of a church since 1888. He has not been a large number of denominations.
