MAKE THINGS LIVELY AT CIVIC MEETING.

They Criticized the Light Plant Affairs Severely—Request of Locomotive Works—City Should Have Purchasing Official.

Ald. Polson and Elliott made things lively at the light and power committee meeting yesterday afternoon. They vigorously criticized the manner in which the plant affairs were being conducted.

Regarding the Locomotive Works, Mr. Campbell stated that the city would make money by granting Mr. Bermingham's request to supply power for three months at three cents a kilowatt-hour.

Ald. Polson declared that the first duty of the committee was to the public. If power could be manufactured at such a low rate, then the committee should reduce its rates at once.

Ald. Polson and Elliott claimed that three months was sufficient time in which to figure the cost of production. It should take a whole year.

Ald. Polson said that cost of production could not be figured earlier, for the reason that the city didn't have a complete plant. It had been buying apparatus for a whole year.
