BRITISH EMPIRE COUNCIL OF RUGBY UNIONS.

Wanted By New South Wales—Comments on Queen's Hockey Team—The Play Grounds in London.

The International league hockey championship will, in all probability, be won by the Michigan 800. The annual bonspiel of the Northern International curling association will be held at Sudbury this week.

The New South Wales rugby union wants a council of rugby unions throughout the British empire.

IMPURE WATER USED BY A MILK VENDOR.

Case of Typhoid May Have Originated From It—The Limits for Ice Cutting in the Harbor Will Not Be Changed.

The February meeting of the Board of Health, held yesterday afternoon at 3 o'clock, in attendance were: John McIntyre, R.C., chairman; Mayor Morat, Dr. Evans, J. D. Thompson, D. Reeves, S. S. Corbett, Medical Health Officer Bell and Sanitary City Solicitor Melnyre.

The chairman's opinion was that the Board of Health is authorized only to inspect the condition of ships and vessels when there are any diseases suspected there are infectious diseases on board. The structural alterations of ships cannot be dealt with by the legislature, as shipping is entirely in control of the Canadian parliament.
