FATAL SYRUPS SAID TO HAVE KILLED OFF MILLIONS.

Startling Statement by United States Professor of Chemistry.—Impure Milk Still Worse.

Washington, Feb. 9.—That more than a million infants had been sacrificed to the various concoctions known as soothing syrups and painkillers, and over twice that number killed by impure milk, was the declaration made by Professor H. W. Wiley, chief of the chemistry bureau of the United States department of agriculture.

"We do not know anything about the milk we have left at our homes, or the condition under which it was produced," he added. "There are a thousand and one possibilities which might have combined to make what nature intended for a food the most virile poison that chemistry can produce."

"I have found that the foods we daily consume are so fraught with germ life of a harmful nature that I am almost afraid to go to the table. The butter is tainted; there is little other to be found anywhere. Canned goods are kept for years and sold for the genuine article. I speak particularly of condensed milk. If we know nothing of the fresh milk we get, surely our knowledge is more limited as to the product that is put in cans. The Lord intended us to resort to cans only to ride us over one season, until green fruits could be had again, but the canneries don't know this. There is no law requiring them to stamp the date upon their goods; if they did it would kill the sale."

THANKFUL RUSSIA. Greatness and Happiness Ascribed to Czar.

St. Petersburg, Feb. 8.—A delegation of citizens of Ekaterinodar, Caucasus, sent to St. Petersburg to obtain the emperor's personal assurance that the land question would not be solved by the present government, out by the national assembly, was received in audience by Premier Witte yesterday.

The premier pointed out that the agrarian problem could not be solved by a division of the state lands alone. The peasants must be prepared to lay private lands on the easy installment plan.

The spokesman of the delegation replied that the peasants did not wish to buy land, but were determined to receive it as a gift from the government.

At the close of an informal discussion the premier thanked heaven that the conditions in Russia were different from those prevailing in other countries. The premier is said to have added:

"The greatness and happiness of Russians are due to the emperor. Without the emperor you who now wear cloaks and high hats would still be peasants."

LIPTON A FARM HAND.

Came Steerage to America in 1865.
