GOOD FLOW OF OIL. In Western Oil and Coal Co.'s Well.

Dear Sir—In response to your request that I make a further report, detailing the progress of our work since my last report of April 12th, 1905:

In June last we overcame the difficulty of the tools, which your former driller got stuck in the No. 3 well on September 12th, 1904, and shortly after began drilling with some degree of success, although it was impossible to push the work as rapidly as I could otherwise have done.

The well is now down to 1,584 feet in depth. At 1,265 feet we struck a considerable flow of oil. I took out, at the time, about ten barrels of oil, very fine in grade and of light specific gravity.

This oil was in a shale formation and was contained in what were not obliged to the main pool, but that the oil was coming up from some considerable distance below us and forced up by extraordinary gas pressure.

We have had a good deal of oil and gas since the well was first discovered. The gas has come in very strong, sometimes to such an extent that it was unsafe to keep lamps lighted at night, near the hole.

On each occasion, when we have had a flow of gas it has been followed by a considerable flow of oil. This has been steadily increasing on each occasion.

At present we are in a soap-stone formation exactly similar to the soapstones encountered in the oil fields of Ohio, Ontario and Pennsylvania.

This I regard as by far the most favorable indication that we have yet encountered, and strengthens my opinion that this will prove a very productive oil field.

As to the work on the No. 4 well, it is impossible to make any very accurate estimate. The strata are all enormously thick; much more so than in any field in which I have worked before.

Probably five thousand people, directly and indirectly, draw their living from these ores. It is only twenty years since the ores were first discovered here.
