### FOSTER-PARENTS

SOME INSTANCES OF CURIOUS ANIMAL-FRIENDSHIPS.

High Development of Maternal Instinct Among Humbler Animal Orders—Many Instances of Wolf-Children in India—Mowgli Founded on Fact.

The subject of foster-parentage among the lower animals is always interesting, and rarely does a season pass without furnishing some new instances of the high developments of the maternal instinct among the members of the humbler animal orders.

The past year has been prolific of examples of which have been particularly curious by reason of the diversity between the foster-parent, and the adopted child or children.

Early in the past summer a female fox at Thornton Marshes, near Pickering, gave birth to a litter of pups, all of which died. A few days afterwards the collie brought home in its mouth a very young rabbit, and set it down to mother it.

No man's quaint animal picture could be imagined that of the rabbit sitting on the back of the sleeping dog, which under ordinary circumstances would hunt the furry tribe with the greatest zest, yet to its adopted child showed the utmost care and fondness.

But perhaps an even more extraordinary case, in which, also, a rabbit was the adopted child, occurred in the spring at Garstang, in Lancashire, where the foster-parent was a female ferret.

A lad who kept a pair of ferrets found a nest of four young rabbits, which he took home and gave to his pet. The male ferret soon killed three of the rabbits, the fourth was taken in hand by the female, which, instead of giving it the deadly nip in the neck nestled up to the shrinking little form, and the pair subsequently became fast friends.

Birds figure in many striking cases of foster-parentage. A few months ago at the house of a Grayson poultry farmer, there might have been seen a very pretty spectacle of tiny chicks being mothered by a cat. The little birds were in the habit of nesting under the soft fur of their foster-parent, and though they were often hours clambering over the cat's body, she never once lost patience with them.
