There, surrounded by her dogs, and a few companions who remained faithful when the days of grandeur and prosperity had gone, Eugenie, one time empress of the French, and most flattered of sovereigns, is quietly entering the valley of the shadow. She will be eighty years of age on the 6th of May.

No more pathetic figure exists in all Europe than this white-haired, somber-clad woman, once the joint occupant of a powerful throne and the centre of the world's most brilliant court.

More often she is seen alone than accompanied by any person. The dreary loneliness of her life is expressed in her daily habits.
