In London, England, Hackenschmidt, the Russian wrestler, demonstrated Saturday night that he is by far alone in his class when he wrestled Madrali, the latest "Terrible Turk" for the championship of the world at catch-as-catch-can wrestling.

MURDERED 36 WOMEN. Fiendish Old Shoemaker in Morocco Will Be Crucified.

London, May 1.-A Daily Mail correspondent writing from Mogador, Morocco, via Tangier, on Saturday, reports: "A series of murders, probably unexampled in the annals of crime, was traced last week to a native cobbler named Hadj Mohammed Mesfoud, a resident in his shop in the Bayad Zeitoun no fewer than twenty-six corpses were unearthed. This led to the discovery of ten more in a yard which had been rented by the murderer."

Mesfoud will be crucified on Thursday next, when an immense concourse of spectators is certain.

"This form of capital punishment has not been practised within living memory."

Esquimaux Garrison. Ottawa, May 1.-The militia department took over Esquimaux to-day.

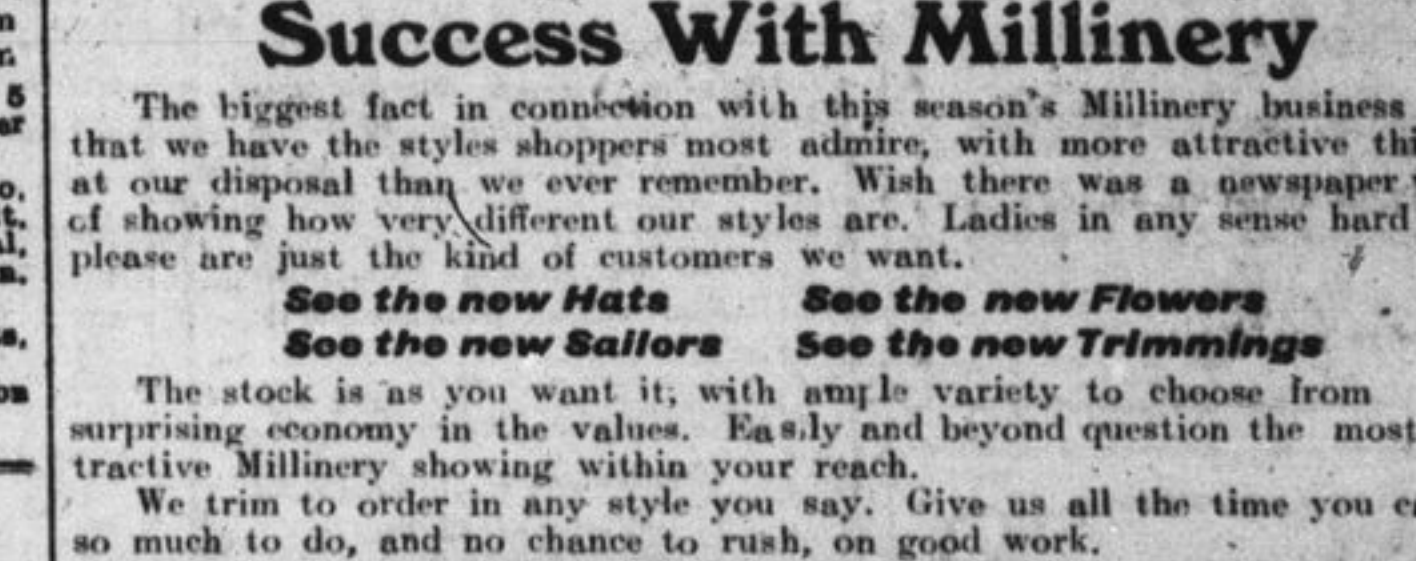
