

Yale. Professor's Findings-Ten Students Were Experimented With, and as Time Went by They Ate Less and Gained Greater Powers of Endurance.

New Haven, Conn., May 10 .- Prof. Irving Fisher, of Yale, has concluded an experiment covering ten weeks, in relation of endurance to diet, and last night he published the first statement of the result. Nine Yale graduates were selected for the experiment, and were given one test after the Christmas holidays, when they were fresh from vacations, and another after a term of hard work. The experiment consisted in trying to find a truer food instinct than most persons are said to have. No attempt was made to prescribe a diet or forcibly alter quantity of proportions of the food. 
