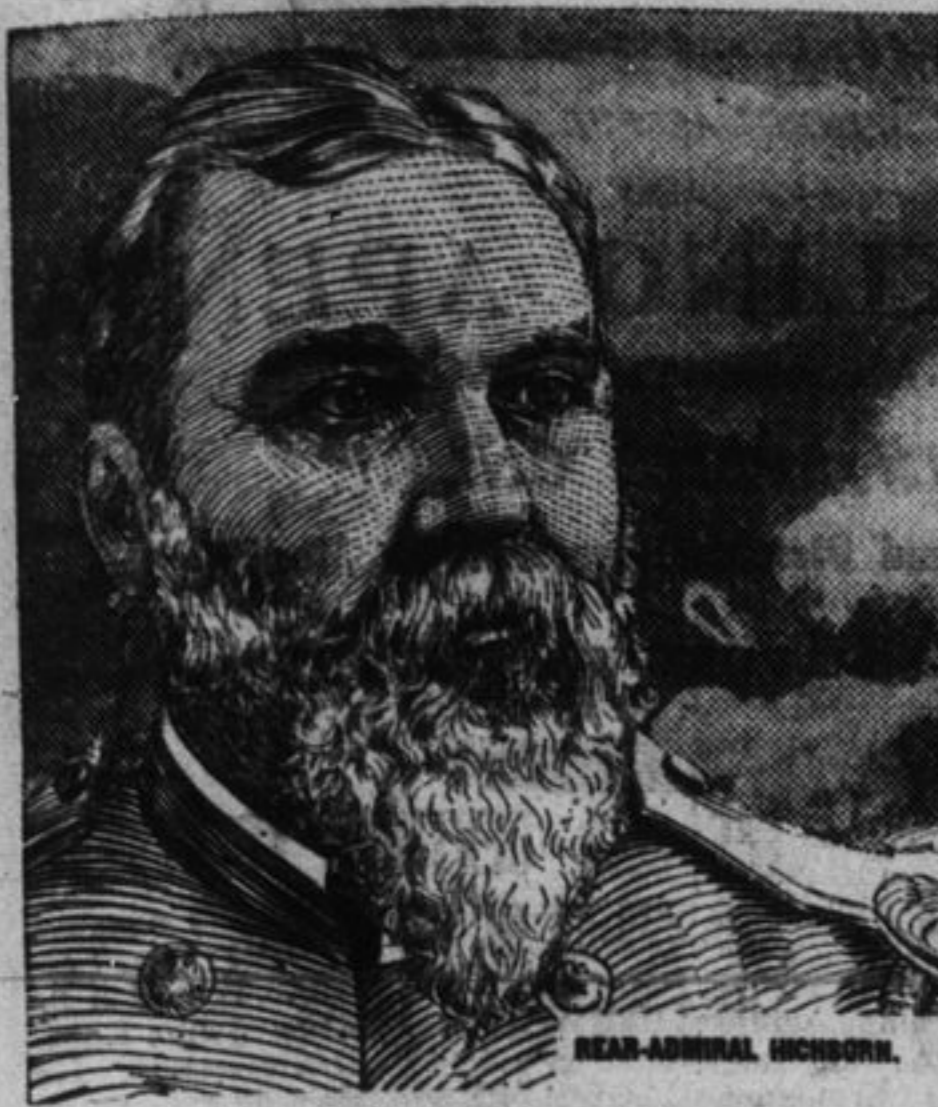

Place d'Armes, east side, from Ordinance street to Queen street. Sydney street, west side, from Ordinance street to Colborne street.

Wellington street, west side, from Gore street to Union street. West street, east side, from Earl street to Sydney street.

West street, west side, from Sydney street south 141 feet. William street, north side, from King street to Ontario street.

Wellington street, west side, from Union street to West street, north side, by along West street to Union street.
