COMMERCIAL MATTERS.

What Is Going On in the Business World—The Markets. Kalgoorlie, Western Australia is one of the newest and richest gold fields in the world.

A contract was signed hereby J. G. White & Co., a New York engineering firm, to build a high speed main line, costing \$2,400,000, between Rochester and Lockport for a syndicate represented by Frederick Nichols, E. H. Wood and Sir Henry M. Pellatt, of Toronto.

The Transvaal gold output in April was 499,248 ounces, which brings the total for the first four months of the year up to 1,719,272 ounces, as compared with 1,495,079 ounces in the corresponding period of 1909, which was the record gold production year.

The statement of the Canadian chartered banks, given their position on April 30th shows total outstanding circulation of \$69,690,077 as compared with \$70,941,646 a year ago. Deposits during April increased \$9,300,000, and notes circulation increased about \$600,000.

The present total production of rubber throughout the world is estimated by French experts at \$7,000,000,000. Of this total 25 per cent comes from America and Africa.
