THE ONLY SOLUTION IS TO SEND PERSECUTED JEWS TO PALESTINE.

These in Free Canada Do Not Think of Going Back to the Holy Land—The Jewish Colonial Trust. That the Zionist movement is more than a mere fact among Canadian Hebrews was evidenced both by the large attendance at the opening meetings of the seventh convention of the Federation of Zionist Societies of the Dominion and by the spirit of enthusiasm which prevailed among the delegates who had travelled from all parts of Canada to take part in the proceedings, says the Toronto Mail-Emquirer.

The London Standard says: The protest made against Go-Between, probably the most important, on the ground that he was improperly described as a gelding, took on a new phase yesterday when the veterinary surgeons, appointed by the stewards of the Ontario Jockey clubs, alleged the gelding, cured the distemper, Sheephead Bay, meeting, reported that after examination of the animal they found the statements in the protest to be correct, and certified that Go-Between is a stallion and not a gelding, as he has been described in entries throughout the four years of his racing career. The report of the veterinary surgeons made it plain that for four years Go-Between had raced in a capacity not properly his, and reportedly has received an allowance in which he was not entitled.
