Traces Of Prehistoric Race. Berlin, July 5 .- At the last meeting f the Academy of Sciences in this city, some interesting details were given of the success attained by the Prussian Exploration Expedition to Chinese Turkestan.

A letter was read from Prof. Gruenwedel, dated "Komura, near Kutcha," stating that the Mingoi Caves had been explored, but that the expected find of manuscripts had proved insignificant, the Japanese having cleared most of them away in 1903. Most interesting archaelogical discoveries, lowever, were made.

Remains were found of persons be-longing to a red-haired, blue-eyed race, evidently the founders in the Mingoi caves, and bearing garments of un-mistakable Iranian origin.
