BRITAIN SURPRISED

OVER CABINET'S PLANS FOR ARMY AND NAVY.

Objections to Reduction—Tremendous Storm Over the Proposal to Abandon Building of a Big Battleship.

New York, July 16.—A special cable to the New York Herald from London says: "Nothing that the present or any other British government has ever done or proposed has stricken the country with so much surprise as the cabinet plan for the reorganization of the army and the reduction of the navy, and this right in the face of the opinions of the highest military authorities in the land."

Lord Roberts spoke most earnestly and fully about the inadequacy of the British army to meet such demands as might be made upon it in case of war with any great power.

Lord Lansdowne and other empire-makers spoke boldly in favor of strengthening the army, and said Europe is in a state of unstable unrest, in the last that should be taken for even a nominal reduction of the British fighting strength.

CRIME IN FIGURES.

Statistics For England and Wales For the Year 1904—Enormous Total of Persons Tried.

A bluebook was issued recently, says Lloyd's Weekly, by the Home Office giving the criminal statistics of England and Wales for the year 1904.

There has been a continuous growth of crime since 1899, when the number of persons tried was 50,484, or 154.37 per 100,000 of the population.

During the year 9,918 persons were convicted in Courts of Assize and Quarter Sessions, of whom 21 were sentenced to death, 970 to penal servitude.
