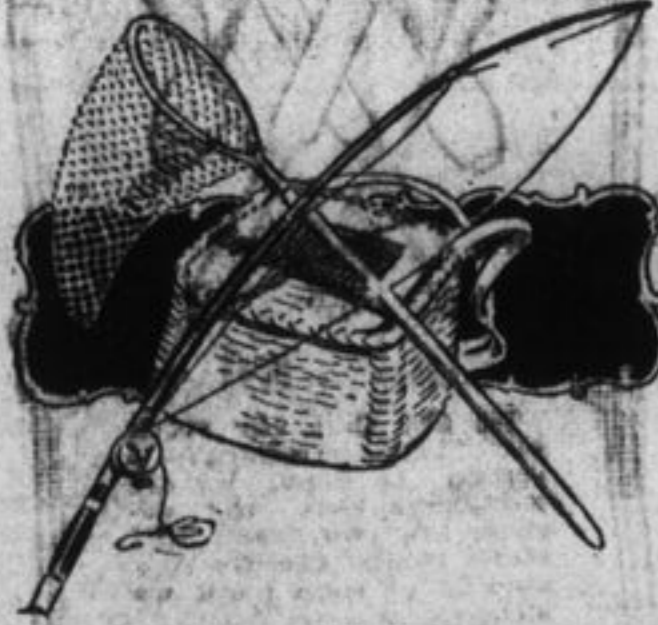

SAYS M. IVOFF

THE NEW MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE.

Thirty Professional Men, Ex-Doumaites, Arrested—100 Finnish Constitutional Democrats Support Viborg Manifesto—Disorders Spread in Caucasus.

St. Petersburg, July 27.—About thirty professional men, including eight ex-members of the Douma, assembled, yesterday, at the house of Prof. Borodine, to hear a communication regarding the events following the dissolution of the Douma. While the meeting was in progress the police entered and arrested them all, and detained a number of documents. An English correspondent, who was present, was also arrested, but released upon identification.

The Viborg manifesto prepared and issued by ex-members of the Douma, has now been signed by 217 of the ex-members. These all expect that government prosecution will be instituted against them, and that they will be disqualified from standing as candidates at the next election of deputies.

It is stated Nicholas Iyoff, who represented Stratoff in the Douma, has been persuaded to accept the portfolio of minister of agriculture. M. Iyoff, who is a liberal, declares they will survive in the agrarian provinces this autumn, who shoot the straightest.

The newspapers say the governors of the provinces have been ordered to prevent all meetings between the democrats and laborites, and have been told to use troops, if necessary, to do this.

One hundred constitutional democrats met, yesterday, in Toripki, Finland, to discuss the carrying out of the plans of resistance to taxation and recruiting laid down in the manifesto adopted by the Douma at Viborg.

Disorders are spreading in the Caucasus and artillery has been used against rioters at Shusha.

CHOKED TO DEATH.

Bell Boy Caught By The Neck By Elevator.

Albany, N.Y., July 27.—George Miller, a bell-boy, said to be from Philadelphia, was killed by the elevator at the Globe Hotel. He had gone to the second floor above the office on the elevator, and a few minutes later an employe was startled at seeing Miller with his head thrust through the elevator door, the glass of which was missing.

On top of his head was the elevator, which had caught him by the neck, holding him fast and choking the life out of him against the door and window casing. He was dead. Evidently he had thrust his head through the door to see where the elevator was, and it had descended upon him before he had time to dodge back.

Sen. Lipp's Slayer Hanged.

Montgomery, Ala., July 27.—John Williams of Cullman, the murderer of State Senator Robert Lipp, was executed by hanging to-day. The crime for which Williams paid the death penalty was the shooting of the senator at Birmingham, Ala., on May 1, 1905. Williams was accompanied by officers of the law, attempted to force a writ depriving Williams of his farm in Cullman county. Williams entered the bedroom of his house, picked up a rifle and opened fire. He wounded one of the officers accompanying Mr. Lipp, seriously, while another shot him in the back of the head of the senator, as the latter was leaving the house.

Upton Sinclair For Congress.

Trenton, N.J., July 27.—The socialists of Mercer county will hold a convention this afternoon for the purpose of nominating candidates for the coming fall campaign. It is almost a certainty that Upton Sinclair, the author of "The Jungle," will be nominated for congress. It is quite certain that Mr. Sinclair will accept the nomination, as he has already expressed his readiness to do so. He lives in Princeton, but is a prominent member of the Mercer county socialists.

Denies Whole Story.

Paris, July 27.—An official denial is issued to-day regarding the rumor that Major Dreyfus had been assaulted yesterday by a brother officer of the Military Club. The official statement says: "A denial of the most formal kind is authorized concerning the incident which it is rumored occurred last night at the Military Club during a dinner at which Major Dreyfus was present."

Countess Says It Is Not Proper To Expose Charms.

Paris, July 27.—Parisian modesty is much interested over the "window blouse" which is the French phrase equivalent to "peek-a-boo waist." The ethics of giving bird's-eye views of a woman's neck to the public she is in America. Countess De Noailles, who is an authority in the fashionable world, has settled it as far as French society is concerned. Her dictum is as quaint as it is radical. "I cannot admit," she says, "that it is decorous to expose our shoulders to the criticism of the coquette and the coquette's admirer."

But the countess wishes it understood that this decision in no wise affects the wearing of low-necked gowns at ball or opera.

Different In Ballroom.

"There," she explains, "we assume that we are among well-bred people, our equals, or nearly so—and at night we are not subjected to the close scrutiny of every passer-by."

WINNIPEG FAIR.

Campaign Against Illicit Sale of Liquor.

Winnipeg, July 27.—The license department carried on a vigorous campaign against the sale of liquor on the fair grounds, and many of the booths have been raided and liquor confiscated. The basement of the government building resembles an inland revenue bonded warehouse, there being in store there and safely fenced up no less than 250 cases of beer, 6,000 bottles and twenty-eight gallon kegs of the same beverage. In addition to the beer, several cases of high-class "hard" goods were also secured, and are being kept safely in the vaults against the loss of the booths in which the stuff was found when they come up for trial.

OVER TWO MILLION IN TAXES.

What Marshall Field Estate Will Have to Pay.

Chicago, July 27.—The three-cornered controversy between the board of directors of the Marshall Field estate, and the city corporation counsel's office, came to an end yesterday when the taxing body decided that the Field estate should be taxed \$2,000,000, which is more than the total amount of \$1,800,000 this year, including back taxes. The decision means that the assessors of the estate will be compelled to pay the county \$2,000,000, which is more than the total amount of \$1,800,000 this year, including back taxes.

NOT TO EXCEED.

The Crop That Was Gathered in 1905.

Toronto, July 27.—The Ogilvie have issued another estimate, reaffirming their opinion, that the wheat yield will not exceed that of last year, notwithstanding the increased acreage. They speak of rust and damage by hail. The Saskatchewan department of agriculture, however, declares the crop is fully as good as last year, and no information regarding rust as yet has been received.

PICKPOCKETS AT ST. ANNE.

Large Sums Taken From Pockets of the Crowd Here, Yesterday.

Quebec, July 27.—Pickpockets, yesterday, made a good haul at St. Anne de Beaufort, where thousands of pilgrims are gathered. A number of them were relieved of good sums of money, and hundreds of dollars worth of suitcases were dispatched. Among the sufferers was a lady who lost \$180 and two gentlemen, one of whom was relieved of \$180 and the other of \$75.

Troubling Poachers.

Toronto, July 27.—A special service man cruising the north shore of Georgian Bay, has been doing excellent work for the fisheries department. His boat is equipped with a swift steam launch and generally, at night, coasts along the shore, lifting traps, which he afterwards burns. Two reports have been received from him, one for the week ending July 14th, when he lifted thirteen traps, and the other for week ending July 21st, when he captured seven trout. He also held up twenty-six Americans for fishing without a license and took them to Penetanguishene, where they received angling permits.

With White Girl.

Louisville, Ky., July 27.—Henry Claytor, a negro arrested yesterday in a charge of kidnapping a white girl, had eloped from Irvington, Ky., was placed in the county jail here, to-day, for safe-keeping. Word was received by police here that a mob was forming at Irvington to lynch Claytor.

Elected A Liberal.

London, July 27.—The election in the Bodmin division of Cornwall, to fill the vacancy in the House of Commons, caused by the unseating on petitions of Thomas Charles Agnew-Barbier, liberal, eldest son of Viscount Ribblesdale, resulted in the return of Freeman Thomas, liberal, by a majority of 1,093.

Shot In Dublin.

Dublin, July 27.—Two rural guardsmen were shot and killed in a crowded street here, yesterday afternoon. The perpetrators of the outrage escaped.

IT'S ALL RIGHT

British Columbia's Salmon Canneries Clean.

ALL SATISFACTORY

INSPECTORS FOUND ALL THINGS PERFECTLY FRESH.

Salmon Fished Fresh From Cold Waters of Pacific—Assurances That Everything is Good and Wholesome.

Ottawa, July 27.—In connection with the announcement of the Chicago canned meat revelations and their possible effect upon markets for canned goods, the minister of marine and fisheries ordered the British Columbia fisheries commission, then sitting, to investigate and inspect salmon canning operations and salmon canneries from hygienic and sanitary standpoint.

Mr. Broderick has received this report. It says: The commission has made a thorough inspection of the canneries operating in the Fraser river district. We were accompanied by Mr. Fagat, of the provincial board of health. Without exception we found the sanitary conditions satisfactory.

The salmon being packed were fresh from the cold waters of the Pacific and were placed in the cans in absolutely a fresh condition and in the most cleanly manner. We found no cause for complaint. The provincial government board of health maintains a continuous and systematic inspection of all the canneries each year. From our inspection we have 16 assurances that the salmon canned in this province is fresh and wholesome. The report is signed by Commissioner Sweeney, Babcock and Brown.

WILL MAKE IT WARM
