UNEARTH ANCIENT HISTORY... People and Customs of 3500 Years Ago Revealed. Chicago, Sept. 17.—Excavation of the ancient City of Gezer, mentioned in early sacred and profane history, carried on by members of the Palestine Exploration Fund for the last three years, have developed numerous "finds," according to advices from Jerusalem published in the September number of the Biblical World, issued from the University of Chicago press yesterday.

Eight cities have been found superimposed upon each other, on the side of the old defences to the western road (St. Jerusalem) from the mountains of Judah. The culture, history, religion and customs from as far back as 3500 B.C. have been revealed by architecture, jewelry, weapons, masonry, etc.

Work of excavating is temporarily suspended, as the three years Turkish firm has expired. It is hoped to secure a new firm, when the research again will be resumed.
