It Will Supply One Thousand Horse Power—The Structure Will Be of Concrete—Plans Ready For Other Extensions.

A force of men are at work driving piles for the foundation of the new power house for the locomotive works.

The structure will be erected at the foot of William street, on the right side. At present there is a space of water surrounded by wharf.

Mr. Birmingham, managing director of the works, showed a plan representative of the plans for the power house and explained some interesting features in connection.

The new power plant for the works will contain the very latest and most expensive machinery to be purchased in the electrical market.
