SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

Any alien homestead section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Provinces, containing 8 and 20, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres, more or less.

An application for homestead entry or inspection must be made in person by the applicant at the office of the local Agent or Sub-Agent.

When an entry is summarily cancelled or voluntarily relinquished, the applicant for inspection must state in writing the reasons for his failure to comply with the regulations.

At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three years.

Coal-Gold lands may be purchased at \$10 per acre for soft coal and \$20 for anthracite.
