SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Province, excepting 8 and 20, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age, or female over 16 years of age, of 160 acres, more or less.

Application for homestead entry or inspection must be made in person by the applicant at the office of the local Agent of the Department.

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Where an entry is summarily cancelled or voluntarily abandoned, subsequent to the date of the cancellation, the applicant for homestead will be entitled to priority for the same.

DR. GRAHAM BELL

Gives Statistics on Inter-Marriages.

Dr. Graham Bell, while now no longer engaged on electrical work, is far from resting idle. When he was in Toronto he spoke to some newspaper men the results of an investigation he was making into the antecedents of blind and dumb parents. Writing now in connection with the United States census returns, he says: "The most significant fact to be derived from the figures given in table 19, is found in the showing that of 2,537 blind whom parents were causing, 632, or 25 per cent, are congenitally blind, of whom 330, or 52.4 per cent, also have blind relatives of the classes specified, while among the 55,960 who were not so related, the number of congenitally blind is but 43 per cent, and of these only 1,027 per cent, have blind relatives. The most striking feature seems to be the large proportion among those whose parents were cousins. The percentage of the congenitally deaf is nearly three times as great among those whose parents were cousins as among those whose parents were not."

Curious Phenomenon

In Connection With French Tobacco Monopoly.

Paris, Oct. 20.—A curious phenomenon noted in connection with the returns of the French tobacco monopoly is that every August the receipts show a great increase over the monthly average.

This year the receipts were \$200,000 above the usual amount and the theory is now put forward that the advance is caused by schoolboys who, during August, are away from their "lycees" and able to indulge themselves with the forbidden pleasure of smoking.

The larger boys get permission from their parents, while their younger brothers find many more opportunities for surreptitious cigarettes than they can get at school. Thus the state gains a comfortable profit from the part of young France.
