IS MAKING CHANGES CHINA IS KEEPING BUSY MAKING THEM.

Laws of Ancestors Good For Their Time, But Not For Present—The Situation is Dangerous. Pekin, Nov. 10.—An imperial edict providing for the re-organization of the government was published in the Official Gazette yesterday.

The edict, after referring to the previous command that the nation prepare for a constitution, outlines many changes in the administrative system, such as the consolidation of various boards, the creation and abolition of others, and the establishment of a political council whose duty shall be to gather public opinion.

Chicago, Nov. 10.—The New York correspondent of the Inter-Ocean says: Though defeated for the governorship, William R. Hearst, with his attorney-general elected, may yet win the mayorality of New York.

New York, Nov. 10.—By the terms of the will of Mrs. Caroline Herriman Polhemus \$405,000 has been left to charity. Mrs. Polhemus was the widow of Henry D. Polhemus, who was well known in Brooklyn as the founder of several notable charities.
