A LAMENTED DEATH

JOSEPH BAWDEN FELL INTO THE WATER.

He Was Out Rowing When It is Supposed He Was Stricken With Apoplexy—He Was a Successful Lawyer.

Joseph Bawden, the well-known barrister, lost his life on Tuesday afternoon. The circumstances under which the accident occurred are shrouded in mystery.

After lunch on Tuesday Mr. Bawden went down to Booth's coal yard and bought a ton of coal, putting the receipt in his coat pocket.

Another theory is that Mr. Bawden, after having rowed a considerable distance towards the Meles buoy, found he was growing chilly in the face of the westerly wind blowing and that he rose to put on his coat.

Joseph Bawden spent all his life in this city, a kindly, independent man, of an original mind; a versatile writer on economic subjects.

Active and constant watch was kept for the body, but up to noon nothing was discovered. At 12:30 o'clock word came from Welle Island that a body had come ashore there.

The body was found on the shore by John Cleary, whose farm is below that of Welle, east of the village. Mr. Cleary reported that the body was that of a man in his shirt sleeves.
