

HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS, Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Province, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres, more

Application for homestead entry or inspection must be made in person by the applicant at the office of the local Agent or Sub-agent.

An application for entry or inspec An application for entry or inspection made personally at any Sub-agent's office may be wired to the local Agent by the Sub-agent, at the expense of the applicant, and it the land applied for is application is to have priority and the land will be held until the mecessary papers to complete the transaction are received by mail.

In case of "personation" the entry will be summarily cancefled and the applicant will forfeit all priority of claim.

An applicant for inspection must be eligible for homestead entry, and only one application has been disposed of.

A homesteader whose entry is in good standing and not liable to cancellation, may, subject to approval of Department, relinquish it in favour of father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister, if eligible, but to no one else, on filing declaration of sbandonment.

Where an entry is summarily cancelled or voluntarily ahandoned, subsequent to institution of cancellation proceedings.

At least \$100 must be expended on the claim each year or paid to the mining recorder in lieu thereof. When \$500 has been expended or paid, the locator may, upon having a survey made, and upon complying with other requirements, purchase the land at \$1 per acre.

The patent provides for the payment of a royalty of 24 per cent on the sales.

Placer mining claims generally are 100 feet square entry fee \$5, renewable yearly.

Where an entry is summarily cancelled or voluntarily ahandoned, subsequent to institution of cancellation proceedings, the applicant for inspection will be entitled to prior right of entry.

Applicants for inspection must state in what particulars the homesteader is in default, and if subsequentry the statement is found to be incorrect in material particulars, the applicant will lose any prior right of re-entry should the land become vacant, or if entry has been granted it may be summarily cancelled.
