SHOCKING NEGLECT

Has Led to the Death of An Infant.

Quebec, Nov. 21.—When Coroner Jolicoeur went to St. Thés des Caps, yesterday, to hold an inquest on the body of a young child which had been reported to have died suddenly, he discovered that the death of the child was the result of one of the most shocking instances of neglect that has been reported for a long time. It appears that the child died from an attack of diphtheria and that the ill-fated little victim had received no medical attention whatever, its parents failing to call a physician or to take any steps to remedy its serious condition. Dr. Jolicoeur, upon learning of the facts of the case, read its heartless parents a very severe lesson upon their criminal neglect, which he said was wholly without excuse, there being a medical man in the parish who could and should have been called in to attend to the child.

Swiss Governess Goes Mad and Murders a Child With Whom She Had Played.

New York, Nov. 21.—Rosa Nangle, a governess, and nurse of Peter, now 18 months old, returning to this city from a visit to her native land, won the hearts of all the women and children in the cabin of the big new Holland-American steamship New Amsterdam from Rotterdam and Boulogne. She embarked at the latter port and straightaway walked right into the affections of the youngsters and their mothers. She said she had been in the service of some of the most prominent New York families, and that she never was really happy unless she had children about her. Dr. Kelly, surgeon of the New Amsterdam, looked upon her passion for children as somewhat in the nature of monomania.

TOE GREW UNTIL CUT OFF.

Shortening Ineffective, is Removed in Its Entirety.


Saginaw, Mich., Nov. 21.—A case that has baffled the surgeons of this city is that of George F. Kern, who lives in the village of Frankenth, Saginaw county. Mr. Kern was born with a toe—the second on his right foot—which kept on growing after his foot reached mature size.

In less than a year it had grown half an inch longer than its associates and he was unable to wear a shoe. He had the superfluous length cut off, but the toe continued to grow. Successive operations followed until he estimates that six inches in all was removed.

Finally the doctors decided the only way to stop the growing toe was to amputate it at the base, and Mr. Kern has just submitted to the operation.
