THE SPORT REVIEW WILL QUEEN'S BE AWARDED CHAMPIONSHIP?

The Intercollegiate Rugby Situation—Varsity May Yet Lose Her Chance to Play For Dominion Honors.

There is a likelihood of Queen's being placed at the top of the Intercollegiate Rugby League on account of the wonderful acts of Ottawa College and Toronto Varsity in playing intelligible men.

Varsity is still hopeful that Powers will be declared as eligible in the early matches he played. The point for the board of reference to decide is not whether he is eligible now, but whether he was eligible when he played.

The Intercollegiate Amateur Union was formed in order to bring about a high standard in the conduct of college athletics.

It is a new body, and is to start now by ignoring the constitution on practically the first instance where its rulings are to have force.

Toronto is likely to be placed severely, but the fault lies entirely with the athletic director of that institution.

To ignore the constitution in the present case is to open the door for irregularities which would bring college athletics in Canada into the disrepute into which they have fallen from time to time on the other side of the line.

The board of reference has the power to interpret and enforce the rules of the union, and of the three colleges represented on this board, namely, Toronto, McGill and Queen's, Toronto alone sends on calling the three games in question forfeits.

Queen's insists that the constitution was enforced in the case of the Ontario College team, which loses the victory over Queen's in the opening game of the season for a similar reason, an exception cannot be made in the case of Toronto.

McGill stands for the enforcement of the letter of the constitution on principle.

In college circles the opinion is expressed that Varsity may not be permitted to play Hamilton this winter on the city, but some of the officers are afraid to undertake the management.

If the 11th decide to enter this winter it will be the first militia body to go in for amateur sport of this kind.
