WAS GREAT HAVOC BY THE EARTHQUAKES AND TIDAL WAVES.

There was Much Loss of Life - The Country was Devastated For Miles About - The German Mission Station Gone.

Victoria, B.C., Nov. 26. - Alarming earthquake shocks in German New Guinea, in the Bismarck archipelago, followed by tidal waves, causing much loss of life among the natives.

A tidal wave swept the low-lying coast, devastating the country for fifty miles. At Chissai Island, in Dampier Straits, the tidal wave wrought great havoc, hardly a native but being left.

Along the New Guinea coast, Capt. Prejawa saw figures in the mountain sides 200 feet long and 100 feet deep. The only European property destroyed was the German mission station.

Capt. Prejawa was unable to estimate the loss of life, but thought it considerable. SIGHT RECOVERY. A Curious Case Reported From Leeds.

In Atlanta, as in most cities south of New England, one cannot enter a train without exhibiting a ticket and having it punched at the gates. An Atlanta man to suit a woman with a good deal of hand baggage, bought a ticket to the nearest station beyond the price named. It was stamped "refundable if not used."

The purchaser before leaving the station presented it for redemption, but this was refused. He then went to the local court, which decided in his favor. The railroad company then appealed to a higher court on the ground that in his purchase of the ticket he simply proposed to enter into a contract and his purpose was to defraud.

Again the purchaser obtained a judgment and the case is before the supreme court of Georgia. The principle of the plaintiff is that the railroad had no right to question his motives when purchasing a ticket for redemption, and that of the railroad company is that the existence of the gate system is at issue.

Highly important decisions have been based on issues involving small money considerations. The supreme court of the United States last winter gave a good deal of time and research to a case returned before it on an appeal involving only \$24. A railroad was in this case the defendant.
