KING SEES A GHOST BUT IT HAS NOT DISTURBED HIM.

He Continues to Occupy the Same Chamber Once a Year and to Enjoy it—What King Edward Knows.

King Edward is claimed, vouchers for the existence of at least one of the four ghosts which haunt Rufford Abbey, where he has been staying throughout the last week, during the Doncaster races, as the ghost of Lord and Lady Savile, writes the Marquis de Fontenay.
