OF CANADIAN NGRTH-WEST HOMESTEAD REGULATION S Any even numbered section of Domin-ion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Province, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres, more

Application for homestead entry or ction must be made in person by the plicant at the office of the local Agent Cution for entry may be wired to the local Agent by the Sub-agent, at the expense of the applicant, and if the land applied for is wacant on receipt of the telegram such application is to have priority and the land will be held until the necessary papers to complete the transaction are received by mail.

In case of "personation" the entry will be summarily cancelled and the applicant will forfalt all priority of claim.

An applicant for inspection must be eligible for homestead entry, and only one application for inspection will be received from an individual until that application has been disposed of.

A homesteader whose entry is in good standing and not liable to cancellation, may, subject to approval of Department, relinguish it in favour of father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister, if son, daughter, brother or sister, if eligible, but to no one else, on filing deciaration of ahandonwest. ciaration of Shandonment.

Where an entry is summarily cancelled by voluntarily abandoned, subsequent to institution of hancellation proceedings, the applicant for inspection will be entitled to prior right of entry.

Applicants for inspection must state in what particulars the homesteader is in default, and if subsequentry the statement is found to be incorrect in material particulars, the applicant will lose any prior right of re-entry should the land become vacant, or if entry has been granted it may be summarily cancelled.

Duties:—A settler is required to perform the conditions under one of the following plans:—

Coal.—Coal lands may be purchased at \$10 per acre for soft coal and \$20 for anthracite. Not more than 320 acres can be acquired by one individual or company. Royalty at the rate of ten cents per ton of 2,000 pounds shall be

collected on the gross output.

Quartz.—A free miner's certificate 'is granted upon payment in advance of \$5 per annum for an individual, and from \$50 to \$100 per annum for a company according to capital.

A free miner, having discovered miner-in place, may locate a claim 1,500x

The fee for recording a claim is \$5.

At least \$100 must be expended on the claim each year or paid to the mining recorder in lieu thereof. When \$500 has been expended or paid, the locator may, upon having a survey made, and upon complying with other requirements, purchase the land at \$1 per acre.

The patent provides for the payment of a royalty of 2+ per cent on the sales.

Placer mining claims generally are 100 feet square entry fee \$5, renewable

A free miner may obtain two leases to dredge for gold of five miles each for a term of twenty years, renewable at the discretion of the Minister of the Interior.

The leases shall have a dredge in operation within one season from the date of the lease for each five miles. Rental \$10 per annum for each mile of river leased. Royalty at the rate of 24 per cent collected on the output after it exceeds \$10,000.




