Any even numbered section of Domin-ion Lands in Manituba or the North-West Province, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres, more

made personally at any Sub-agent's other may be wired to the local Agent by the Sub-agent, at the expense of the applicant, and if the land applied for is vacant on receipt of the telegram such application is to have priority and the land will be held until the necessary papers to complete the transaction are In case of "personation" the entry will be summarily cancelled and the applicant will forfeit all priority of claim.

An applicant for inspection must be eligible for homestead entry, and only one application for inspection will be received from an individual until that application has been disposed of.

A homesteader whose entry is in good standing and not liable to cancellation, may subject to approval of Department

relinquish it in favour of father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister, if eligible, but to no one else, on filing declaration of abandonment.

Applicants for inspection must state in what particulars the homesteader is in default, and if subsequentry the statement is found to be incorrect in mater particulars, the applicant will lose land become vacant, or if entry has been granted it may be summarily cancelled.

the settler must give six months' notice in writing to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, of his inten-SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST MINING REGULATIONS.

Coal.—Coal lands may be purchased at \$10 per acre for soft coal and \$20 for anthracite. Not more than 320 acres can be acquired by one individual or company. Royalty at the rate of ten llected on the gross output.
Quartz.—A free miner's certificate granted upon payment in advance of \$5 per annum for an individual, and from 50 to \$100 per annum for a company eccording to capital. A free miner, having discovered miner-in place, may locate a claim 1,500x The fee for recording a claim is \$5.

At least \$100 must be expended on the claim each year or paid to the mining recorder in lieu thereof. When \$500 has been expended or paid, the locator may. upon having a survey made, and complying with other requirements, pur-chase the land at \$1 per acre.

The patent provides for the payment of a royalty of 24 per cent on the sales. Placer mining claims generally are 100 feet square entry fee \$5, renewable A free miner may obtain two leases

dredge for gold of five miles each for a term of twenty years, renewable at the discretion of the Minister of the Interior.

The lessee shall have a dredge in operation within one season from the date of the lease for each five miles. Rental \$10 per annum for each mile of river leased. 
