Liability to Get Into Upper Levels and Destroy Foundations of Town of Dominion. Sydney, N.S., Dec. 18.—The Hull mine-fire at Sydney may mean the destruction of the town of Dominion, for the town is in large part built over the crop area of the mine.

It is estimated that two billion gallons of water are needed to drown the fire. The Hull is not connected with any of the other mines. When the fire is controlled a new shaft will be sunk, the old one being abandoned.
