LONDON COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSES SCHEME.

Cost Will Be \$47,000,000—Will Cover 451 Miles—Calls For Floating Loan of \$23,000,000 at Outset.

London, Jan. 8.—A gigantic new scheme in municipal trading, in which the county council is preparing to embark, has been announced this week. The council will ask parliament when it re-assembles to sanction a vast electric supply undertaking to serve an area of 451 miles, of which London is the centre.
