Whitney in Cringing Mood... Mr. Whitney is advertising himself as a man who will not do things. When he became premier, backed by a large and servile majority, it seemed as if he could do anything. He was boastful, too. What he undertook he would do. He was not a weak man, not a quitter. In conformity with this spirit was the new public school act. It reflected the mind of the new superintendent, an old teacher who had remembrance of the trustees' parsimony and was disposed to correct it by the force of law.

The new act was certainly coercive in its character. The chief point was that the standard of the teacher should be higher, and that the salary should be commensurate with the position. The law did not leave any choice with the trustees.
