SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST

HOMESEAD REGULATIONS.

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the Northwest Provinces, excepting 3 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres, more or less.

Application for homestead entry or inspection must be made in person by the applicant at the office of the local Agent or Sub-agent. An application for entry or inspection made personally at any Sub-agent's office may be filed at the office of the local Agent, Sub-agent, at the expense of the applicant, and if the land applied for is situated in a reserved area, the necessary papers to complete the transaction are received by mail.

In case of "persecution" the entry will be summarily cancelled and the applicant will forfeit all priority of claim. An application for inspection must be made in person by the applicant, and only one application for inspection will be received from any person residing on the land. If the entry is in good standing and not subject to any claim, it may be subject to approval of the Department, and the land may be sold to the applicant, or to his wife, daughter, brother or sister, if eligible, and to any person residing on the land.

(1) At least six months residence on and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three years. (2) If the father or mother of the settler is deceased, a homestead may be entered for the land in the vicinity of the deceased settler, and the residence may be established by such person as the father or mother.

Coal—Coal lands may be purchased at \$10 per acre for soft coal and \$20 for anthracite. Not more than 320 acres can be acquired by one individual or company. Royalty at the rate of one cent per ton of 2,000 pounds shall be collected on the output after 100,000 tons.
