SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Provinces, sections 8 and 36, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres, more or less.

Application for homestead entry or inspection must be made in person by the applicant at the office of the local Agent or Sub-agent.

An application for entry or inspection may be made to the local Agent by the applicant, and if the land applied for is vacant on record of the Registrar such application is to have priority and the land will be held until the necessary papers to complete the transaction are received by mail.

In case of "personation" the entry will be summarily cancelled and the applicant will forfeit all priority of claim.

A homesteaded section must be in good standing and not liable to cancellation, may, subject to approval of Department, be relinquished in favour of father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister, if eligible, but to no one else, on filing declaration of abandonment.

Where an entry is summarily cancelled or voluntarily abandoned, subsequent to institution of cancellation proceedings, the applicant for inspection will be entitled to prior right.

Applicants for inspection must state in what particular the homestead is in default, and if summarily cancelled, the applicant is to be re-examined in material particulars, the applicant will lose any prior right of re-entry should the land become vacant or if summary cancelled it will be summarily cancelled.

Duties.—A settler is required to perform the duties under one of the following classes:

(1) At least six months residence on and cultivation of the land in each year during the homestead period.

(2) If the father or mother, if the father is deceased, the settler may reside upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for by such homesteader.

(3) If the settler has his permanent residence upon such land, the requirement may be satisfied by residence upon such land.

Before making application for patent the settler must file a declaration in writing to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, of his intention to do so.

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST MINING REGULATIONS.

Coal.—Coal lands may be patented at \$10 per acre for soft coal, and \$20 for anthracite. Not more than 250 acres may be acquired by one individual or company. Royalty at the rate of ten cents per ton for soft coal, and five cents per ton for anthracite.
