

5th, 1900, to the New York Sun, gives new regulations of the Boston Board of Health as to barber shops : "Mugs, shaving brushes and razors shall be sterilized after each separate use thereof. A separate, clean towel shall be used for each person. Material to stop the flow of blood shall be used only in powdered form, and applied on towel. Powder puffs are pronibited.
