NEW CANNING FACTORY.

One at Wellington to be placed.

Pieton, Feb. 18.—Hillier will have a new canning factory for the coming season, for the canning of tomatoes. The new industry will be run by the Bloomfield Packing company. This announcement means plus for Hillier and minus for Wellington. J. F. COMMISSION APPOINTED TO FORMULATE PLANS FOR TREATING CONSUMPTION

A Commission has been appointed by the Governor of Indiana to investigate tuberculosis conditions in the state and to make recommendation to the next general assembly on the legislation that a state farm for the cure of consumption be established.

The Commission has prepared plans that include the expenditure of \$100,000 for the purchase of about 200 acres of good land and provide the necessary buildings, to care for about 300 people—150 male and 150 female.
