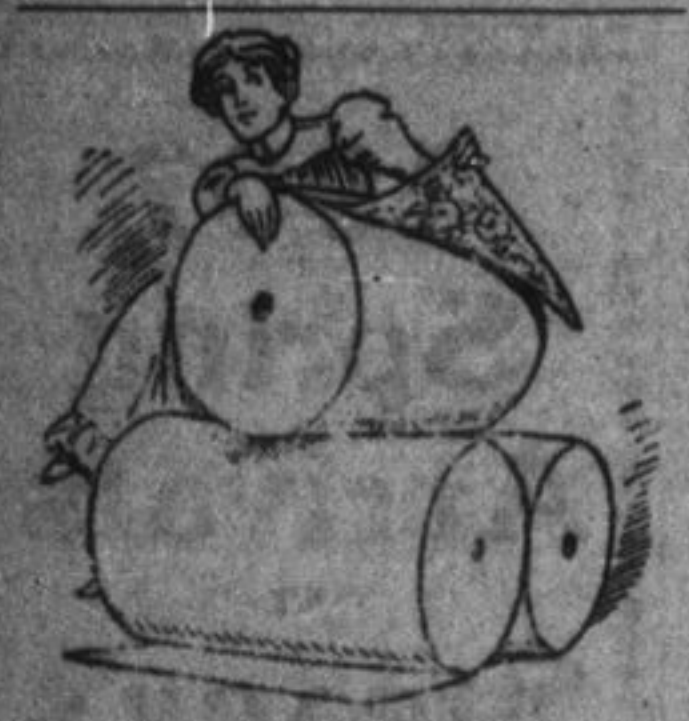

Or the City Will Be Sued—The Government to Be Asked to Do Extensive Work in Kingston Harbor.

The board of works met again, yesterday afternoon, at three o'clock. The members present were: the Mayor, Ald. Gaskin (chairman), Graham, Free, Hanley, Elliott, McLean and Kent were in attendance.

At this juncture, Ald. Toye entered the committee room and Chairman Gaskin at once placed him on the witness stand.

The engineer said that last year, the board of works was given \$13,000 for the streets. This year the engineer said, the board must have at least \$16,000 to do the necessary work.

The city engineer's plan for extending the O'Reill street sewer pipe through a concrete pier, and filling in from the outer point of the pier to the Macdonald park shore was adopted, and tenders for building the pier and laying the pipe will be asked for.

Ald. Gaskin drew attention to the fact that Kingston should ask the Dominion government to do more in the way of improving the harbor.

The question of repairing the streets was again considered, but no definite action was taken. The board recognized that the first thing to settle must be the financial question.
