OCCURRENCES RECORDED IN BRIEF FORM.

Matters That Interest Everybody. Ottawa city council has decided to enforce the early closing by-law.

The Canadian Forestry Association will meet in Ottawa, on March 14th and 15th.

Parliament did not meet to-day in St. Petersburg. The next session will take place on March 8th.

The railway commission is likely to take up the question of the hearing methods in express cars.

W. H. Keir, editor of the Brussels Post, was nominated for the legislature by the liberals of East Huron.

There is trouble between the town authorities of Paris, Ont., and the fire brigade, and the men threaten to resign.

W. E. Fisher, New Haven, Conn., engineer of the special, who disappeared after the head-on collision at Platt's Mills, has surrendered.

R. H. McElroy, Carp, was the unanimous choice of the conservatives of the town county, as successor to the late G. N. Kidd, in the Ontario legislature.

Premier McBride, Vancouver, B.C., has invited the Lord's Day Alliance to meet in conference regarding the enforcement of the Dominion Sunday act observance.

Word has been received of the death in Quebec of August Casgrain, brother of Senator C. E. Casgrain, who is now living in a hopeless condition in the Hotel Dieu, Windsor, Ont.

Grain carriers to load at the opening of navigation are in fair demand, and cargoes are being offered at Duluth and Port William on the basis of two cents on wheat to Buffalo.

An order-in-council has been passed approving the appointment of William Ogilvie, to the railway commission staff, as inspector of railway equipment and safety appliances.

D. W. Belding, Cincinnati, O., seventy-five years of age, founder of the silk manufacturing firm of Belding Bros. & Co., died on Tuesday.

William R. Hearst, addressing a meeting of the Independence League, in Albany, N.Y., on Tuesday, said the organization would break from its alliance with the democratic party.

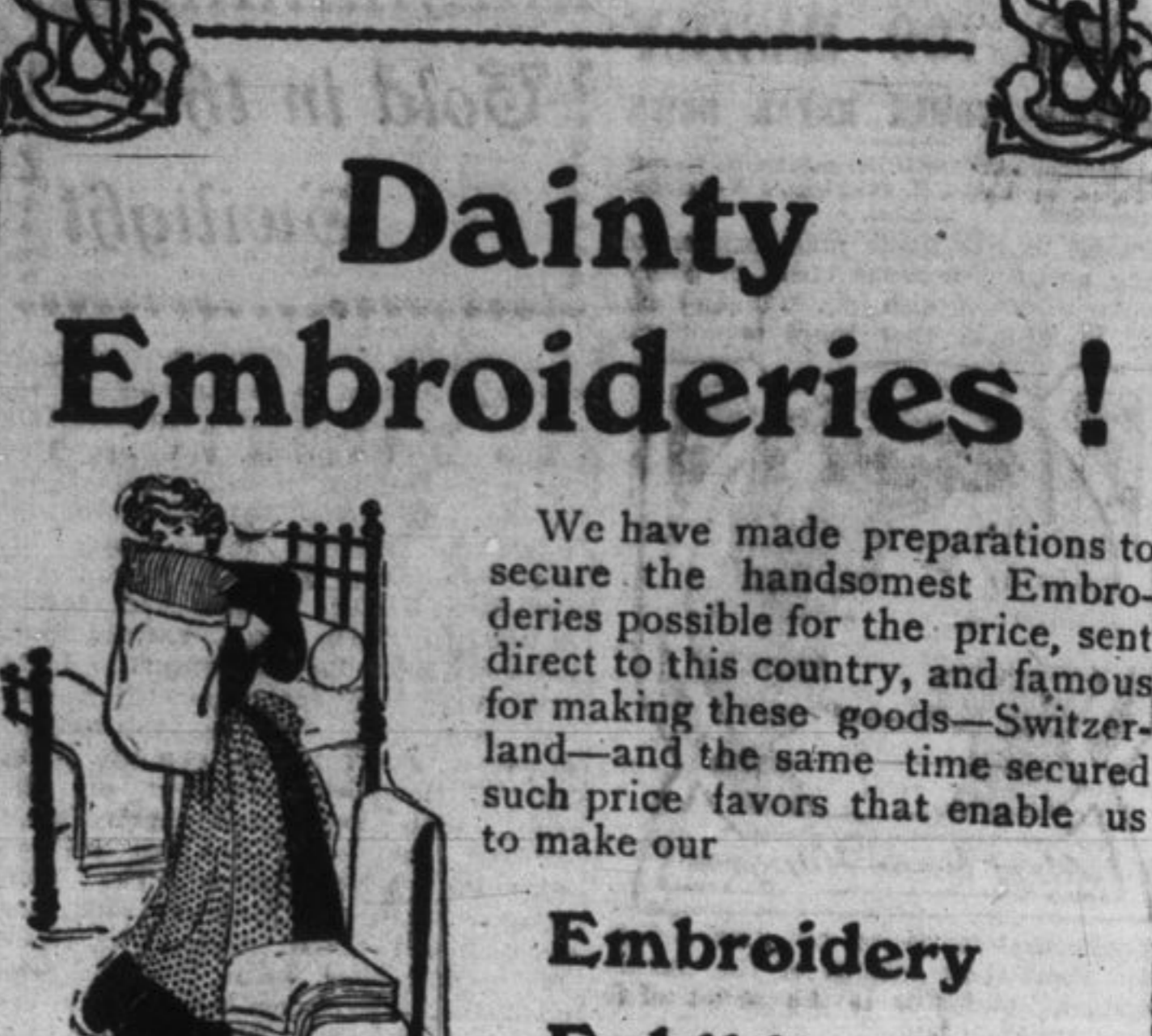
