THE LIGHT PLANT

SURPLUS FOR LAST YEAR WAS \$8,112.16.

Increase of Revenue was \$7,794.64. The Proposed Reduction in Rates and What it Would Entail.

The following is the financial statement of the city light plant for the year 1906:

Gas Department. Revenue for the year 1906, \$33,865.67. Expenditure—Petroleum, \$5,125.61; coal steam, \$1,099.64; line, \$239.41; sundry, \$86.63; wages, \$3,510.49; gas, \$108; oil and waste, \$39.98; water, \$8.02; sundries, \$22.78; gas plant maintenance, \$3,396.23; proportion of stable account, \$60.13; half of J. M. Campbell's salary, \$1,000; half of E. Moore's salary, \$600; total, \$19,779.29; balance surplus, \$14,086.38.

Electric Department. Revenue for the year 1906, \$37,115.12. Expenditure—Oil and grease, \$672.01; waste, \$332.04; fuel, \$6,508.74; water, \$361.15; wages, \$2,151.95; cartons, \$485.17; dynamo rental, \$136; sundries, \$25.73; half of J. M. Campbell's salary, \$1,000; half of E. Moore's salary, \$600; total, \$12,145.72; balance surplus, \$24,969.40.

YEAR'S RECEIPTS.

Tuesday afternoon the Civic Light and Power Committee had the financial statement of the light plant for the past year before it. The gas revenue was \$33,865.67; electric, \$37,115.12; total \$70,980.79; profit on both \$25,982.15. After paying interest, taxes, insurance, etc., the net surplus is \$8,112.16. The earnings for 1906 were ten per cent greater than for 1905, notwithstanding a reduction of rates. There are 1,665 consumers, or an increase of 231 for the year. It is pointed out that the price of lighting gas from \$1.50 to \$1, the same as cooking gas and electric light from twelve to ten cents a kilowatt hour. Even with this reduction it is anticipated that the increased consumption will result in surplus of several thousand dollars this year.

Statement of Expenses. Taxes, \$3,591.70; repairs to buildings \$669.68; debentures and interest, \$13,344.64; printing and stationery, \$447.50; contingencies, \$632.44; office rent, \$260; insurance, \$187.53; plant extension by-law expenses, \$21,627; proportion of salary (city officials), \$1,120; Total, \$29,969.99. Balance (surplus for year 1906), \$8,112.16.

Liabilities And Assets. Liabilities, December 31, 1906, not including bond issue, City of Kingston, \$156.19; accounts payable, \$3,822.55; accrued interest, \$3,480.33; Bank of British North America, \$17,389.11; Total, \$24,969.40.
