SAD FAMILY CASE

ARRIVED IN CITY IN DESTITUTE CIRCUMSTANCES.

Mother Will Endeavor to Have Children Placed in a Home—Husband Died Recently. The sad case of a family came under the notice of the Kingston police to-day. A mother, with her four children, arrived in the city on the morning train, from Uxio Station, in destitute circumstances.

The children were very hungry, also the mother, but she cared not for herself; it was her children she was thinking of. But it did not take the police station long to act. In less than ten minutes she had secured some employment, and also with the idea of placing her children in the home. When they reached the city they had no place to go, and were only directed then to the police station, and here Sergt. Snodden and Constable Driscoll made it as comfortable as possible for them.

The family is composed of two girls and two boys, one aged eight, the other four, the youngest of the family, a girl sixteen and the other six. The elder girl is of a weak mind, and she is unable to give the mother the help that she needs in her time of great trouble. The oldest boy is also of a very weak mind, and suffers a great deal with his eyes. He underwent treatment not long ago in a Kingston hospital, but he has not been able to get much improved as a result.
