Delegations of the fair sex marched on the capital, protesting against taking away woman's chief weapon of defence. Of course, the bill died—and the hatpin survived.

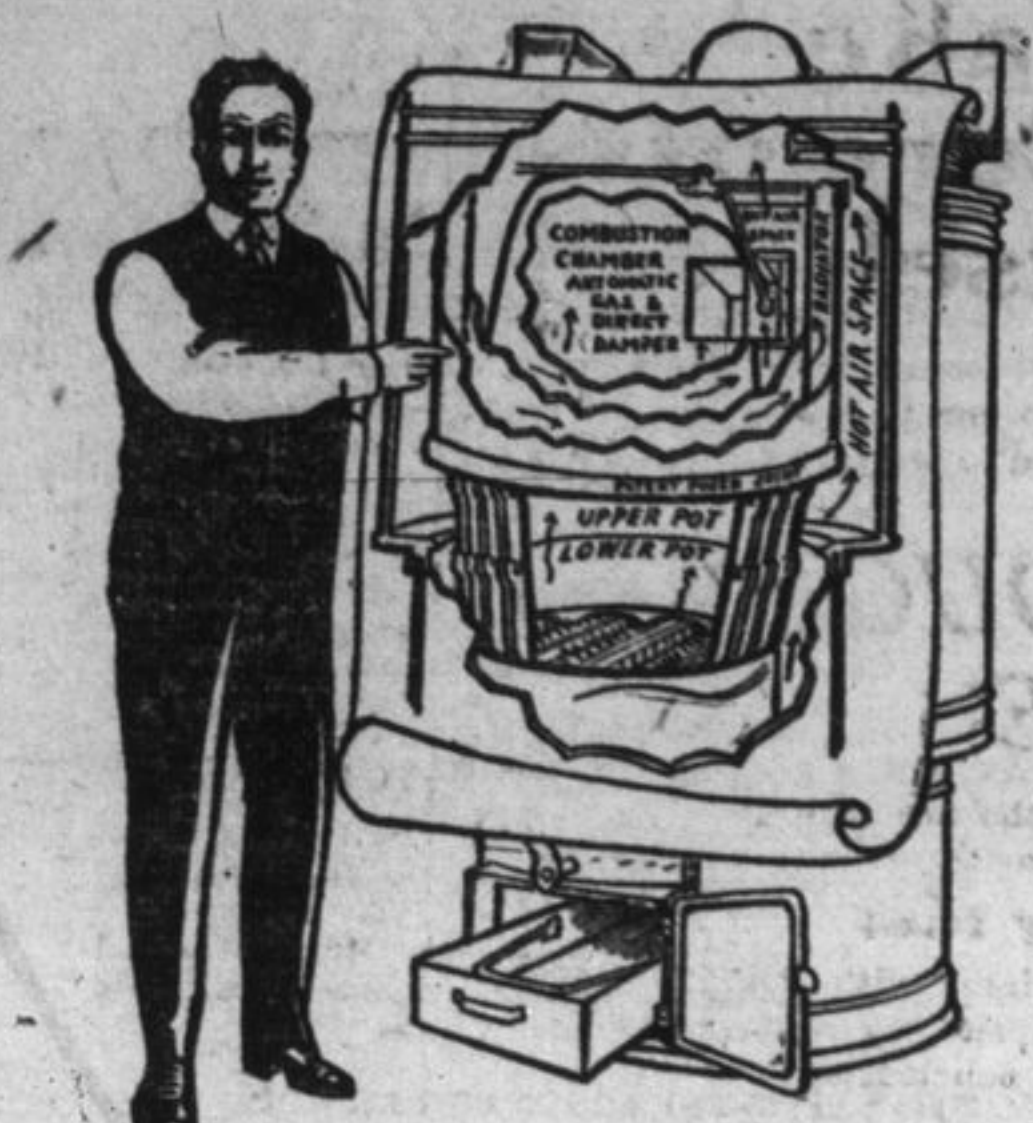
