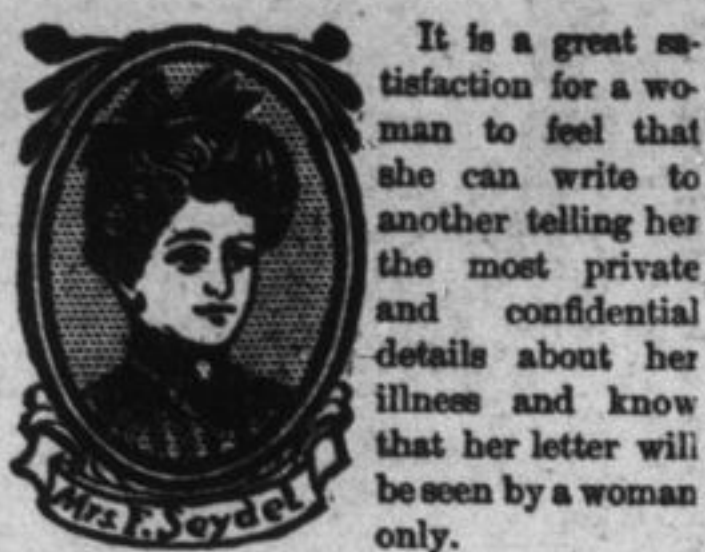

OCCURRENCES RECOUNTED IN BRIEF FORM.

Matthew That Interest Everybody. Notes From All Over--Little of Everything Easily Read and Remembered.

A boiler shop owned by A. Hales was destroyed by fire at Guelph. Thomas S. Barnes, a blacksmith, of Toronto, dropped dead suddenly in Toledo, O.

The Toronto Board of Education appointed H. J. Crawford, principal of Riverside high school.

The jury for a second time disagreed in the trial of Thomas F. Collins for murder at Hope Bay, N.B.

The six-year-old son of C. B. Fillmore was picked up by the fender of a St. Thomas street car and escaped without a scratch.

Mrs. Wootton, an inmate of London Asylum, has committed suicide by drinking carbolic acid, which she had obtained in some unknown manner.

A French proposition, at The Hague, provides that there shall be a declaration of war on the opening of hostilities, an amendment of which the Netherlands urges a delay of twenty-four hours between a declaration of war and the opening of hostilities.

British Divorce Suits. The latest British civil judicial statistics, those for 1926, have just been issued. They show the first decrease since 1899 in legal proceedings, the decline being from 1,518,927 cases in 1924 to 1,473,919.

Governor of Bank. It is interesting to note that the governor of the Bank of England is never a banker. There is no reason why he should not be, and several have should, says F.O.D.

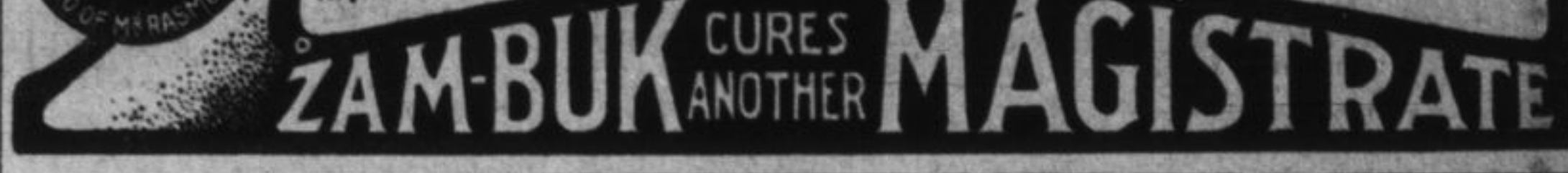
