Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Homestead Regulations.

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Provinces, excepting a 20 acre reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age...

Application for homestead entry or pre-emption must be made in person by the applicant at the office of the local Agent or Sub-Agent. An application for entry or pre-emption made remotely at any Sub-agent's office may be received by the local Agent by the Sub-agent...
