Synopsis of Canadian Northwest HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Provinces, excepting 8 and 16, unit reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or more over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 acres, more or less.

Application for homestead entry or inspection must be made in person by the applicant at the office of the local Agent or Sub-Agent. An application for entry or inspection made erroneously at any Sub-Agent's office may be re-sited to the local agent by the Sub-Agent, at expense of the applicant, and if the land applied for is vacant on receipt of the telegram such application is to have priority and the land will be held until the necessary papers to complete the transaction are received.

Coal—Coal lands may be purchased at \$11 per acre for soft coal and \$20 for anthracite. Not more than 800 acres can be acquired by one individual or company.
