ST. ANDREW'S CHURCH. The Reopening of a Church at Wellington. The reopening of St. Andrew's Church, Wellington, and dedication of the new chancel took place on Wednesday evening, July 10th. A congregation of three hundred early assembled. Many others being turned away for lack of standing room. Rev. Dean Farthing preached an eloquent and forcible sermon. He spoke of the awe of God as a necessary attribute of divine service, that we should endeavor rather than to pull God down to the level of man. He traced the growth of inspired song from the days of Caslin, and of architecture from the rude huts of our Saxon forefathers to the great cathedral churches of this day, and accentuated the influence of these upon character and spirit of worship. The offering amounted to \$95. Rev. A. L. Gen, of Belleville, read the lessons, the incumbent of the parish, Rev. C. R. de Pointe, taking the service. Over \$1,000 has been expended upon this church within three years, making it one of the most church edifices in the diocese. It has been erected at a cost of \$100, and lighted by electricity, at a cost of \$300. The building is cruciform in shape, the electric chandeliers also forming a perfect cross. Two vestries are provided, one on either side of the chancel, for the clergy and the choir; the latter is under the direction of Prof. Rockwell. The chancel will be consecrated on the occasion of the bishop's visit. What now remains to be done is the original church built forty years ago. The nave was built under the incumbency of Rev. Dr. Morkridge. The chancel has just been completed. An examination for promotion to major for officers of the P.A.M.C. will be held in November next at Montreal.
