They leave on short notice, and very many of them are utterly irresponsible. The shortage of labor is enabling us to see the Chinaman in his true light, and there is plenty of evidence that if he is allowed to control the domestic service of the province, our homes would soon be in a state of anarchy.

DOUKHOBORS ON TRAMP.

Intend to Walk to Montreal and Go to Europe.

Winnipeg, Man., July 31.—After a day spent in rest and recuperation at the "All People's Mission," the Doukhobors are away again. The party, thirty-three in number, bundled up their belongings, not a difficult matter, for each carries little more than a handful, and despite all the efforts to persuade them otherwise, went out of the city towards the east on foot.

The Doukhobors earnestly desire to seek an ocean port on the Atlantic, Montreal preferred, and with childlike faith are preparing to march through Canadian territory to that city. It was explained to them that the physical difficulties of such a hazardous undertaking made the feat an almost impossible one.

"But what will you do with your women and children? The women will probably be maltreated on the march," in the various construction camps.

"God will take care of us," one woman answered.

"But it is fifteen hundred miles to Montreal, and part of the country is uninhabited and rocky. How will you live?"

"We can live on berries, and God will feed us."

Their ultimate destination, they say, is South Europe, where they can live in peace. In consideration of the women in the party they will probably go southwards. They have bought new boots with the money collected. They aver that they had been badly treated by the Dominion government, when their lands were taken away from them. They feel it bitterly.

Whiskey Detectives Are In Trouble.

MUST STAND TRIAL

THEY ARE THE GOVERNMENT'S INFORMERS.

Trying to Stir Up the Hot Men—They Fall Into a Trap Themselves—Will Have to Answer Charges of Being Drunk and Disorderly.

Kemptville, Aug. 1.—C. Hanson and A. Belier, the two whiskey "spotters" of the Ontario government, who have been making trouble for hoteliers at Ottawa, Almonte and other places, are under bail, to appear before Police Magistrate Beckett, of Beckett's Landing, on August 29th, on charges of being drunk and disorderly.

The two informers, it is alleged, had been trying to stir up some trouble in Kemptville and Oxford Mills, and it was in the latter place that they are said to have gone past the limit in the amount of liquor they consumed themselves and the quality of language they used towards all and sundry. They had charges against two Kemptville men, and one from Oxford Mills, but all were dismissed for want of proof by Reeves Baker and Justice of the Peace Mosher, of Merrickville, and Justice of the Peace Carson, of Burritt's Rapids.

CANADA'S PROSPERITY.

Ottawa, Aug. 1.—The customs revenue of Canada is growing at a tremendous rate. For the first four months of the present fiscal year to July 31st, the customs revenue shows an increase of almost thirty per cent. Collections during the four months amount to \$20,565,694. In the corresponding four months in the year previous the collections totalled \$15,721,080, the increase amounting to \$4,844,614. For the month of July the customs collections totalled \$5,442,601, being an increase of \$1,860,222 over July of the year before.
