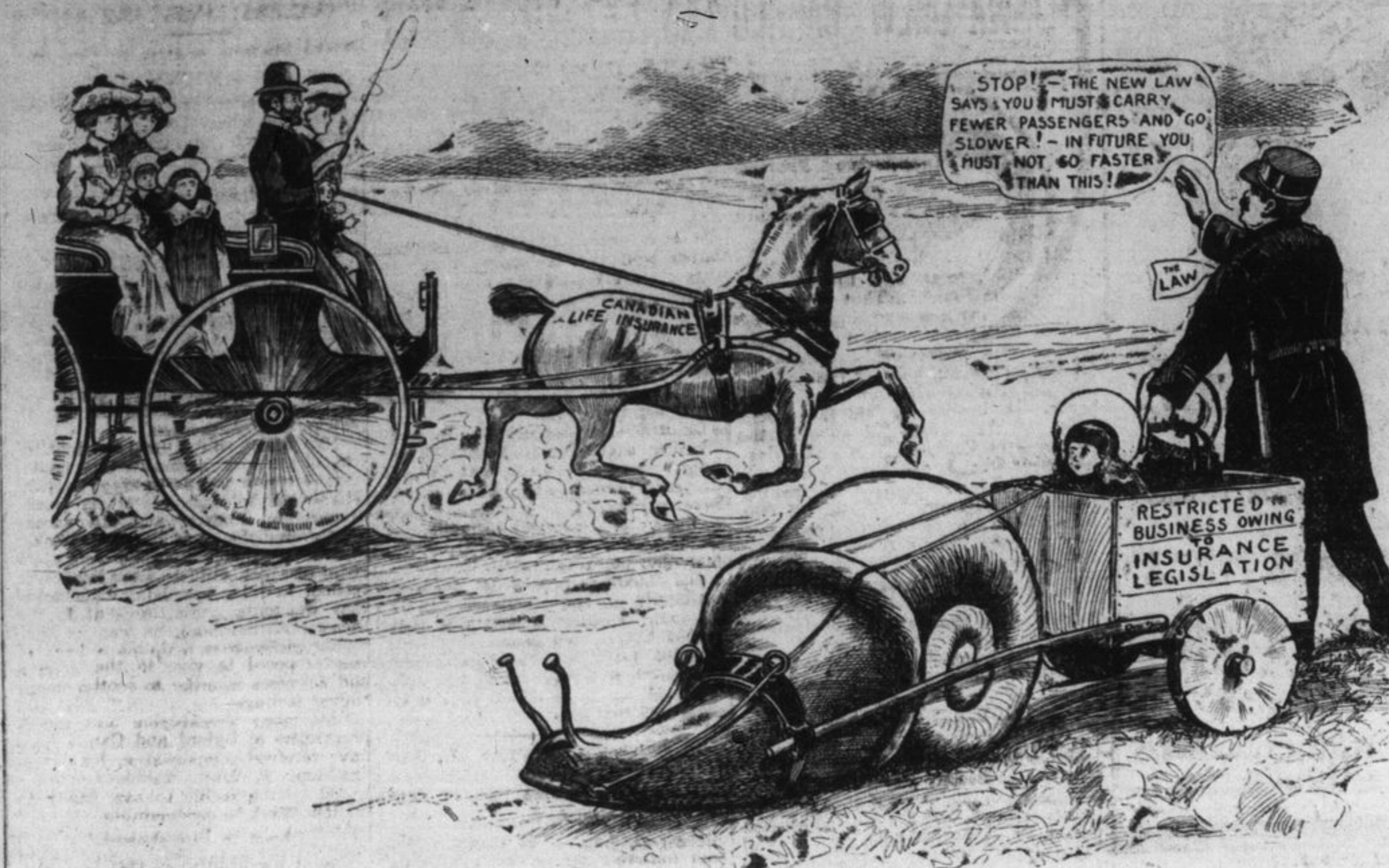

THE PERILS OF LABOR.

No Less Than Ninety-One Fatalities Reported During May. Reports to the Labor Department show that the number of trade disputes during May was 48, an increase of 12 over the corresponding month of 1906. The loss in working days was approximately 89,326 as compared with 45,975 in May of last year. The increase is largely due to the strike of coal miners in the West, and of longshoremen in Montreal. There were about 411 firms and 11,697 employees affected by the various disputes.
