TRAINING OF TEACHERS

ENTHUSIASM AND INTELLIGENCE ARE REQUIRED.

In the Class Room—A Criticism of Examinations—W. S. Ellis, Writer of Education Section.

The whitewash artist at work on a board of examiners does not require a high degree of technical skill, nor much expert knowledge, nor the habits of a student, to do a creditable job for the material he uses in cheap, manipulative, and dishonest ways.

Some remedies might be applied that would at least mitigate the evils arising from this source. There should be, first, a thorough inspection, at least twice a year, of all schools engaged in the preparation of teachers, and the department should be accepted only from those of approved standing.

The other element in training teachers, is the care of them after they get certificates and schools. Inspectors are far too rare, and the result is, especially in rural sections, a routine grind without animation without any great intelligence, and without any enthusiasm.

The training of teachers, however, is an exceedingly complex matter, and the professional work of the normal schools is only a element of several of equal importance. There is, for instance, the non-professional preparation which has to do with the quantity and quality of knowledge, and the capacity to acquire information.

The main objections to the system may be briefly put in this way: The examination questions are set, not by teachers, but generally by university lecturers, who have neither the pedagogical training, nor the familiarity with the aims and methods of either the high or public school which would make them competent for the work assigned to them.

As these examinations practically decide the quality of the teaching in most high schools, hence the scholarly attainment of many public school teachers, the public has the right to insist that competent examiners, from the point of view of the benefit of the schools, shall be in charge of the work, and that the childish contention that teachers cannot be trusted with this duty shall no longer prevail, to the detriment of educational progress.
