

Synopsis of Canadian Northwest HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

Any even numbered section of Dominion lands in Manitoba or the North-West Probe homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age, to he extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres or less.

(3) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his homestead, the requirement may be satisfied by residence upon such land.

Before making application for patent the settler must give six months' notice in writing to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands

Coal.-Coal mining rights may be leased for a period of twenty-one years at an annual rental of \$1 per acre. Not more than 2,560 acres shall be leased to one individual or company. A royalty at the rate of five cents per

At least \$100 must be expended on the ed or paid, the locator may, upon having a survey made, and upon complying with other requirements, purchase the land at \$1 per evalty of 2 1-2 per cent. on the sales. Placer mining claims generally are 100 feet quare, entry tee \$5, renewable yearly. An applicant may obtain two leases to fredge for gold of five miles each for a term

The lessee shall have a dredge in operation within one season from the date of the lease for each mile of river leased. 
