WHERE MATCHES ORIGINATED. "Old Match House" Near Washington. Sixty miles north of Washington, in Maryland, at the foot of the Blue Ridge mountains, stands the little one-story stone house in which the first lucifer match was made.

The father of the inventors was the first settler at Mechanicstown, the name which was afterward changed to Thurmont. In 1811 he started an extensive edge-tool factory which gave the hamlet its first importance.

Joseph Weller and his brother spent their leisure time working on their scheme. They made a brimstone mixture, and continued to experiment. Time and again the mixture failed. In fact, it was months before the invention was made so that any results developed at all.
